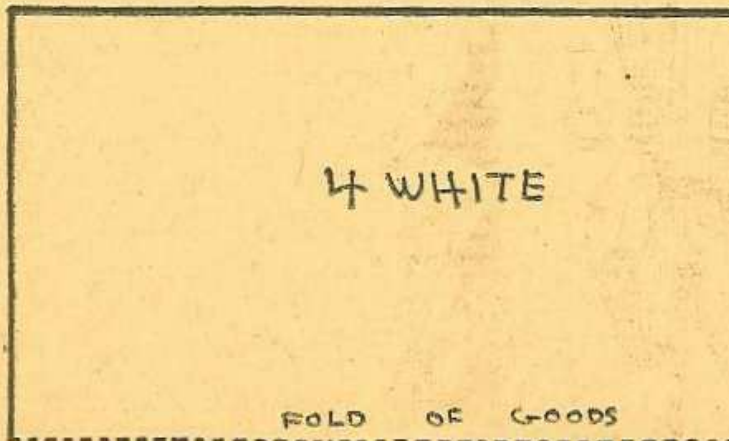
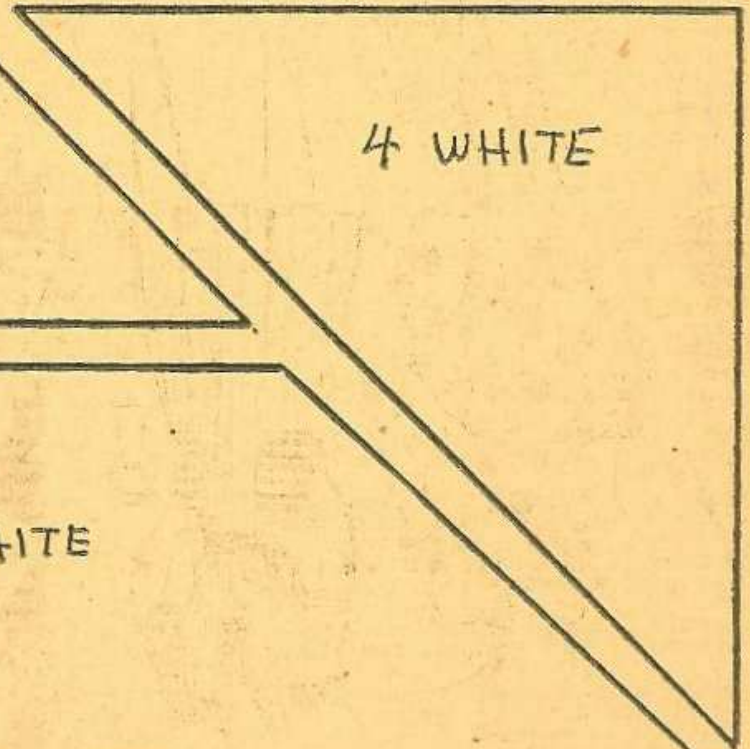
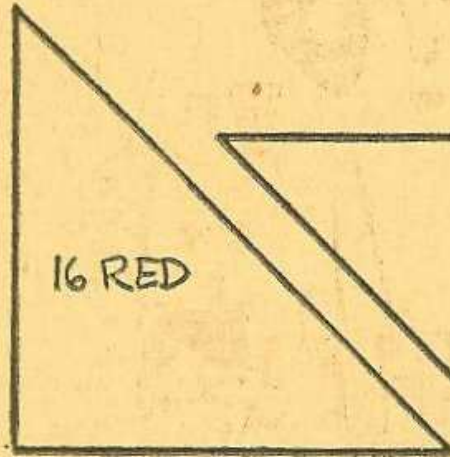
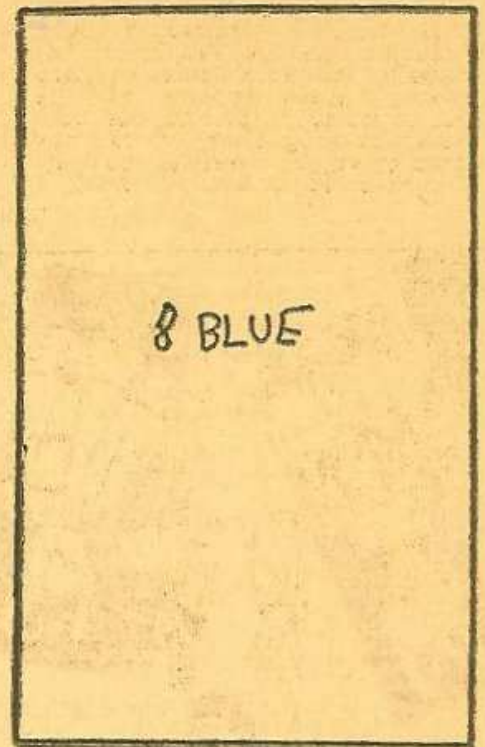
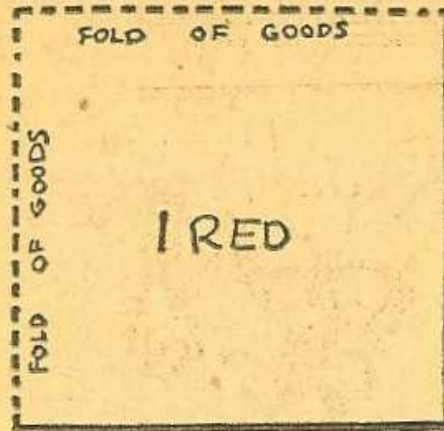
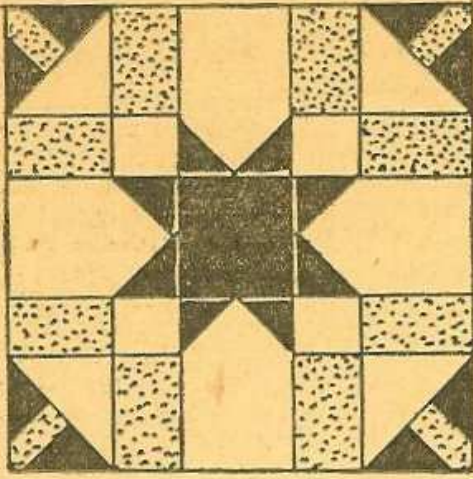


# THE ARMY STAR.
