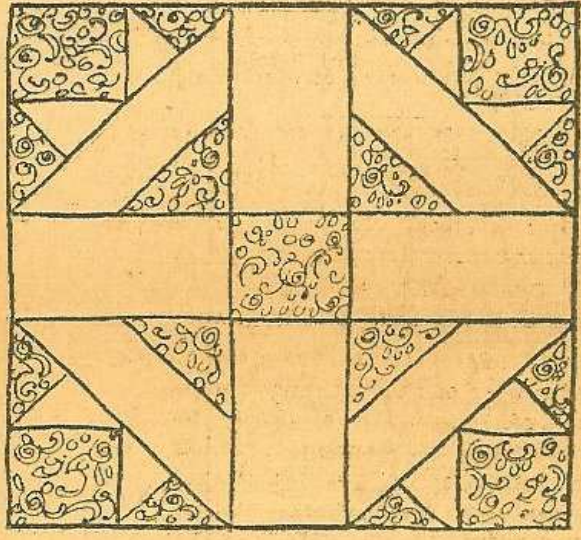
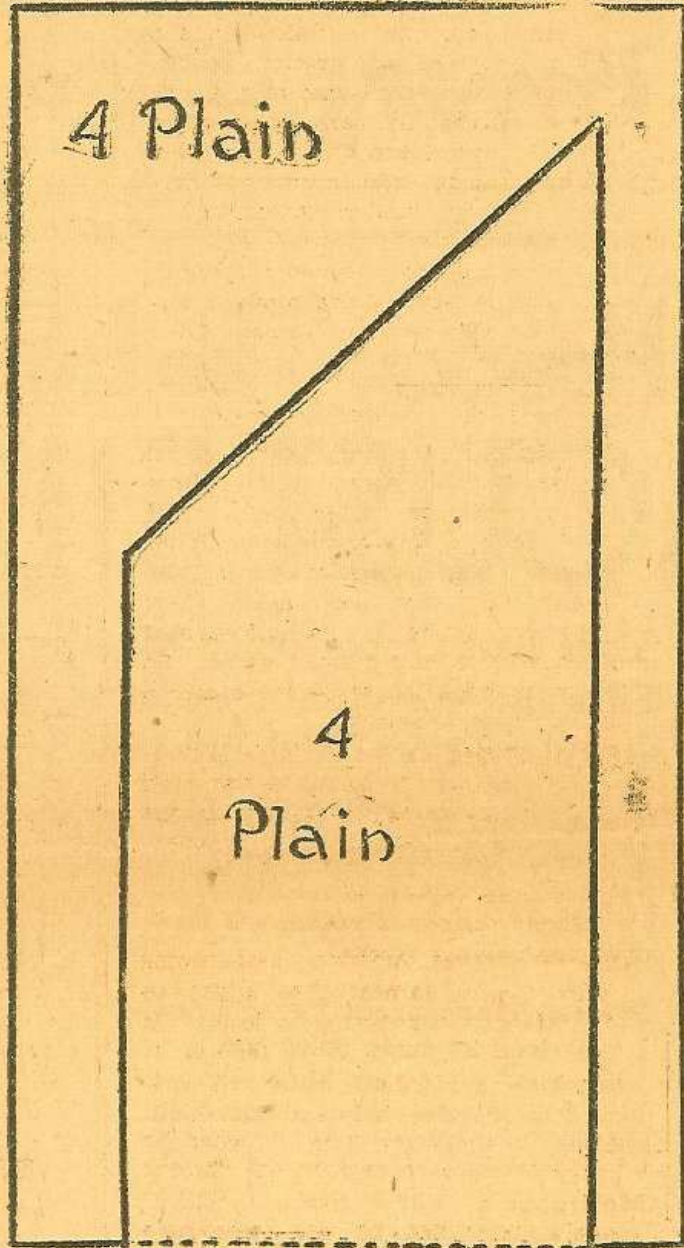
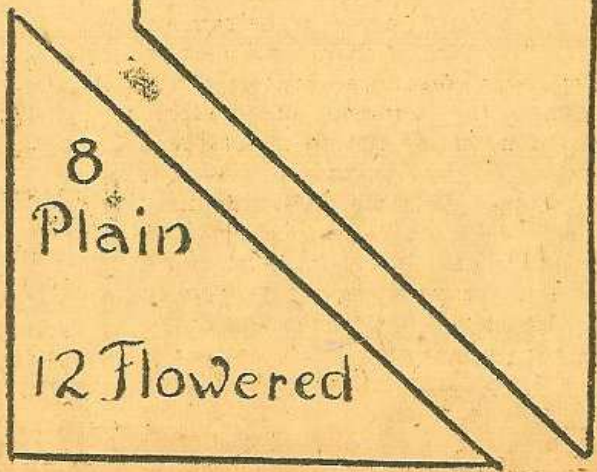


THE CROSS AND CROWN.

Another old-fashioned design for quilts is this, called the Cross and Crown. It makes a large block fourteen inches square. It is very effective when pieced without strips between, the oblong pieces forming a lattice. Although each block consists of thirty-three patches, the Cross and Crown is really very simple to piece. Begin with the center square. And remember to allow one-quarter inch for seams.
